

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IMPORTANT

LOAD RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ensure the load is evenly distributed on the roof. An uneven load can have advserse effects on the handling of the vehicle and the
 performance of the roof rack. Anytime a load is on the roof, the driver must adjust their driving style and act more cautiously.
- Routinely check the roof rack attachment points and ensure they are secure by checking torque, looking for any movement and damage to parts.
- Check tie down straps. Ensure they are tensioned securely. Ensure they are positioned correctly over the load. Ensure they are free from damage and 100% operational.
- Do not use any automatic car wash service.

CARRYING CAPACITY

- Check the vehicle owners handbook for your vehicles maximum carrying capacity. This capacity must then be evenly distributed on the rack.
- The actual load on the vehicle roof = weight of cargo + weight of roof rack system

WARNING

- Read through the fitting instructions completely before installation. Install as described and do not use any other mounting.
- It is advisable to have assistance when lifting heavy components onto the roof area of a vehicle.
- Do not repair or modify this part in any way. Repairs or modifications may effect the operation of the part and can result in a non-compliance with vehicle safety requirements.
- If damage or concerns are identified that may interfere with the installation, or affect the function or safety of the vehicle, inform
 the customer prior to proceeding with the install.

Any part of the system is used with other products or components not intended to be used in conjunction with the system.

The system has been on-sold or assigned by the original purchaser

The system has been modified or repaired by someone other than X-Country or its authorised repairers

X-Country cannot establish any fault after inspection of the returned product

The system has been subject to abnormal conditions, including fire, water, humidity, pressure, stress

The defect in the system, has arisen due to abuse, misuse, neglect or accident


The defect in the system has arisen due to unlawful or unusual use of the vehicle

The defect in the system has arisen due to the purchaser's failure to properly assemble, install, fit, maintain or use the system in accordance with the instructions.




Fit pinch weld to Razors as shown.


Note: Following steps show Dual Cab (XC218) Razor. Similar fitment is undertaken for Single Cab (XC245).


Insert cage nuts into the square holes in the Razor bases.







Fit the wind fairing to the front of the Summit Platform.

Slide 4x M8 x 16mm hex


Place the fairing into place over the hex bolts installed previous. Centre the fairing and tighten in place with flanged nuts.



Install foam 3M pads on the 2nd and 5th mounting point on top of the Razor. Trim to shape.








A) Using the M6 hardware provided, fix the bracket to the inner hole positions front and rear.
